To whom it may concern:

I support and greatly endorse my brother Darin Torbert and sister Carolina Torbert, which is why I affirm my relationship with them through this letter. For over a year I have known them hold them in great esteem. They came as missionaries to the city of Rivera in northern Uruguay. There they worked for almost two years (2005-07) through the ministry of YWAM (Youth with a Mission).

They then returned to Montevideo, the capital of Uruguay, with their entire family to minister in the “School for Transcultural Missionary Intensive Training” from July 5th-31st. There the Torberts trained a large group of Uruguayan Christians.

Both inside and outside our country, they have felt a great yearning for helping the Uruguayan church spread the Gospel by mobilizing and training the believers committed to fulfilling the Great Commission. This past July, they felt the confirmation from God to come to Uruguay in September 2011 to serve the Lord full-time. They plan to assist the church in Uruguay through the beautiful ministry they started, “Catapult Missions” (a non-denominational missionary organization).

Among other projects, this ministry is aimed at:

- A desire to help *catapult* the Uruguayan church leaders, who are called, outside the walls of their congregations, their cities and go to other regions.
- Their vision is to train, encourage and send people from Uruguay and other servants “to the ends of the earth,” with Uruguay being a *launching point*.
- They plan to find and train people—who feel a passion and even a calling to cross-cultural and geographical borders—to carry the message of Jesus Christ inside and outside our country.
- They hope to find and train people in the churches; perhaps the ones that were at one point on fire for evangelism and missionary work, but, for different reasons, have been discouraged. They want to encourage them to feel qualified and return them to their *dreams* given by God.

I fully support Darin and Carolina Torbert throughout their mission project in our country. They are people of great Christian witness and service with a selfless love of the Lord's work. They have the support of our ministry, and the Apostolic Network "New Dawn."
